

Competency Verification

Instructions

It is a supervisor's responsibility to ensure the driver of any vehicle is licensed and competent. A person may be licensed, but not competent, or competent and unlicensed. The checklist below can be used as a Competency Verification; principally for new employees, before permitted to work unsupervised. The activity should take the form of an observed drive in traffic over about an hour. This is not training session.
